



From The Desk Of President

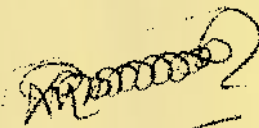
I wish all the members of ASIMA a very Happy New Year-2014. May this new year bring Health, Wealth and Prosperity to all.

Technology Park at Saha & Memo for VAT reduction

On 23-10-2013, the foundation stone of Technology Park at Saha was laid by Chief Minister Bhupinder Singh Hooda. Members of Association, PP Dr. Anil Jain, PP Mr. Ashwani Goel and Mr. Sanjay Gupta, Gen. Secretary attended the meeting. A memo regarding VAT REDUCTION was given to the Industry Minister Mr. Randip Singh Surjewala for forwarding it to the Chief Minister. The CM assured to look into the matter.

ASIMA comes to the Aid of Fire Victims

There was a blast in a glass blowing unit at Khojkipur Village of Ambala on 24-10-2013. An emergency meeting was called at 5 p.m. in Punjabi Mohalla and at a short notice about 60-70 persons from glass blowing units (ASIMA members & non-members) gathered. They were cautioned to take Safety measures in their units. It was decided to give a request letter to Kumari Selja – Union Minister for Social Justice & Employment and MP from Ambala to ensure reasonable financial compensation to the victims. She was also requested to ensure that other glass unit owners were not harassed unnecessarily by the administration.

Fire Safety Norms

Fire Station Officer Mr. A.K.Chopra and his team had started visiting glass blowing units to check for the safety measures in the industry. Most of the members were not aware of these safety measures. The members of Association met FSO and procured First-Aid Fire Safety Norms for the industry in general and glass blowing units in particular. A circular on 22-11-2013 was sent to the members for information and awareness. Following are the first -Aid Fire Safety Norms :

1. Units must have **Buckets With Sand.**
2. **One Fire Extinguisher per 1000 Sq. Ft. area.**
3. LPG cylinder should be used **through a Pipe-Line** only.
4. **An Emergency Display Board** should be fixed on wall with Telephone Numbers of (a) **FIRE BRIGADE (101)** (b) **AMBULANCE (102)** (c) **POLICE (100)**
5. Units using LPG connection must follow common precautions **as directed by LPG companies.**

Seminar on Fire Safety Norms

On 25-12-2013 a seminar was held in Arya Samaj Mandir Bhavan. Sh. Vinay Pratap Singh, SDM Ambala was invited as Chief Guest and Sh. A. K. Chopra, FSO Ambala as Guest of Honour. More than hundred persons, mainly from Glass Blowing Industry, attended the seminar. Sh. Bhushan Oberoi ASIMA Member & President Arya Samaj narrated the profile of Glass Blowing Industry. He said that most of the entrepreneurs of glass blowing units are very small and have investment in the range of Rs. 20000/- to Rs. 50000/- only. They have very little working spaces and it is difficult for them to adopt expensive safety norms. **He also suggested that a separate industrial area should be developed for small glass blowing units. Here the units could get constructed halls of 600-700 Sq. Ft. and LPG be supplied to them through pipe line.**

SDM Sh. Vinay Pratap Singh appreciated the initiative taken by ASIMA to conduct the seminar for the awareness of members. He assured that Administration shall adopt brotherly behavior and shall not impose heavy requirement of safety equipment. SDM informed that one Seminar/Workshop shall be organized in the last week of January for training and awareness on safety norms and equipment.

Fire officer Mr. A. K. Chopra and Industrial Safety Officer Mr. Batra also addressed and expressed their views. Members keenly participated in Question-Answer session. Project Director of the meeting was Past President Mr. Ashwani Goel.
